50 Year Traditions Challenge

Orlando, Fla. (September 23, 2013) – The Student Government Association will be introducing its first-ever traditions challenge in celebration of the University of Central Florida’s half century mark.

The challenge is a list of traditions broken into five subcategories: Campus, Athletic, Academic, Agency, and SGA traditions. Those who accept the dare are required to upload photos of themselves completing each particular item and submit them to the SGA website by 5 p.m. on Thursday, April 10, 2014.

There will be two sets of awards given; one to those who complete 50 percent of the listed items and another to those fantastic Knights who complete the entire booklet.

The commencement of this activity will be kicked-off by an event in the Student Union Atrium on Wednesday, September 25 at 12 p.m. This will be the first time the booklet is officially passed out and the first 50 students will receive an accompanying “UCF 50” cupcake from Sweet! By Good Golly Miss Holly.

With each tradition commemorating a year of this establishment’s existence this will be no easy task; but is designed to teach those who partake of the rich legacy, to introduce fellow Knights of where this concept of knighthood has originated from. While also reinforcing a message of getting involved and embracing the UCF college life.

Starting in the first week of the spring semester students will be able to upload their challenge photos to a platform on the SGA website. Uploading their pictures to the website is the only way SGA can keep track of the traditions they’ve completed.
