UCF Micromobility: Student Government Exploring E-Scooters

ORLANDO, Fla. (August 28, 2019)—This fall UCF Students will no longer be seeing Lime Bikes on campus. Lime’s contract with Student Government was only for one academic year, and Lime chose not to renew. Due to the expiration of the Lime contract combined with an increase in demand for micromobility, the Gray and Mills administration is working to fulfil their campaign promise of bringing E-scooters to campus. Nothing has been finalized but the administration is venturing to find another company to partner with and is currently in an exploratory phase.

In the meantime, students are encouraged to continue using our SGA Bike Share program.

How the SGA Bike Share Program Works:

- **General Overview:**
 - The SGA Bike Share is open to all students with a valid UCF Card.
 - There is no rental fee to rent a bicycle, lock, helmet, and light for one workday.
 - Participants may rent and return our bikes from the Student Union
 - Use of our equipment is strictly on a first-come-first-served basis.
- **How to Rent a Bike**
 - Come to the Student Union
 - Bring your UCF ID
 - Sign the Agreement Form once a semester
 - Grab the bike lock keys, helmet (optional) and light (optional)
 - Enjoy your rental! (See Rental Period for returns)
- **Policies**
 - Bicycles are loaned out for 1 workday (M-TH). Bikes loaned on Friday must be returned by 5PM the following Monday.
 - Rentals will NOT be permitted during semester breaks. Bike Share shuts down for the duration of these breaks.

Terms and Conditions of SGA Bike Share:

1. **Condition:** Bicycle, helmet and lock must be returned in the same conditions as when issued to user.
2. **Age Restriction:** Must be a minimum of 17 years old to participate in this program. By signing this waiver form, user acknowledges they are at least 17 years old.

3. **No Warranty:** UCF makes **no warranties** express or implied, including the warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.
4. **Bicycle Restricted Use Requirements:**
 - a. **Bike for User Only:** User agrees that only they will be riding the bicycle during the term of this bicycle agreement.
 - b. **Helmet Use:** It is highly recommended that a bicycle helmet (that meets the Consumer Product Safety Commission for protective headgear) is worn while riding this loaner bicycle.
5. **Fines or Violations:** User acknowledges that all traffic and parking citations received in the use of this bicycle are the sole responsibility of the user.
6. **Return:** Bicycle and lock must be returned by the end of the loan period. User will be charged a **\$10.00/day late fee**. After 10 business days user will be charged the full cost of the bicycle (\$350) and rented equipment (\$50 for lock and/or key). Failure to return bicycle, helmet and lock will subject user to legal liability of \$400.00, as well as having student account placed on hold.
