- .01 **WHEREAS**, Society of Women Engineers (SWE) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1975;
- .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of the Society of Women Engineers is to stimulate women to achieve full potential in
- .03 careers as engineers and leaders, expand the image of the engineering profession as a positive force in improving
- .04 the quality of life, and demonstrate the value of diversity;
- .05 **WHEREAS**, SWE currently has 65 active, dues-paying members;
- .06 **WHEREAS**, SWE members pay dues of \$20.00 per year;
- .07 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of The SWE National Conference is to provide members with the opportunity to meet
- .08 other members from the organization from around the world;
- .09 **WHEREAS**, SWE members will attend creative and professional workshops, and have the opportunity to network
- .10 with business professionals and companies at the conference;
- .11 **WHEREAS**, SWE members will be lodging at the Residence Inn in Baltimore, MD; and
- .12 **WHEREAS**, Society of Women Engineers received \$0.00 in the 2013-2014 Activity and Service Fee Budget;

**THEREFORE, BE IT**

**ENACTED**, by the Forty-Fifth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$8,982.89 be allocated to the Society of Women Engineers from the Registration and Travel Account (7140-0007) according to the following breakdown:



Total Senate Contribution		\$8,982.89


**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That no funds be spent on Train Passes;
