[Funding for 20 members of Society of Women Engineers to travel to the Society of Women Engineers National Conference in Los Angeles, CA, from October 23-26, 2014]

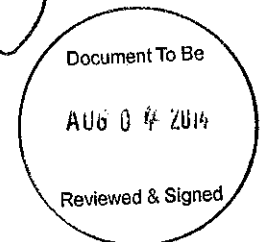
- .01 WHEREAS, Society of Women Engineers (SWE) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1975;
- .02 WHEREAS, The mission of SWE is to stimulate women to achieve full potential in careers as engineers and leaders, expand
- .03 the image of the engineering profession as a positive force in improving the quality of life, and demonstrate the value of
- .04 diversity;
- .05 WHEREAS, SWE members pay dues of \$20.00 annually;
- .06 WHEREAS, SWE currently has 65 active, dues-paying members;
- .07 WHEREAS, The purpose of this conference is to attend creative and professional workshops and network with business
- .08 professionals;
- .09 WHEREAS, Attendants will be participating in workshops, attending guest speaker presentations, developing professional
- .10 careers, and generally developing interest in the engineering community for women;
- .11 WHEREAS, Attendants will be bringing back valuable experience in the engineering field to the UCF community;
- .12 WHEREAS, SWE will be lodging at the Sheraton Downtown and Millennium Biltmore in Los Angeles, CA; and
- .13 WHEREAS, Society of Women Engineers received \$0.00 in the 2014-2015 Activity and Service Fee Budget;
