[Updates to Title VIII: The Finance Code changes to Fiscal Probation Policy]

.01 **WHEREAS**, Statutes are in constant need of revision to best reflect policy and serve the Student Body;
 .02 **WHEREAS**, Current statutes are unclear of Fiscal Probation length and procedures; and
 .03 **WHEREAS**, Revision of these statutes will ensure consistency and clarity of policy and procedures;

 .05 **THEREFORE, BE IT**

.06 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that the following be added to
 .07 Title VIII: The Finance Code:

 .09 **800.16 Individual and Registered Student Organization Fiscal Probation:**

- .10 A. The Student Senate shall refuse to consider all funding requests for an individual or Registered
- .11 Student Organization on Fiscal Probation.
- .12 B. Individuals or Registered Student Organizations shall be automatically placed on Fiscal Probation
- .13 **for one (1) calendar year or until the individual's or Registered Student Organization's**
- .14 **circumstance has been reviewed** in accordance with the current Operations Review Committee
- .15 Fiscal Probation Policy.
- .16 C. Upon the Operations Review Committee placing an individual or Registered Student Organization
- .17 on Fiscal Probation or releasing an individual or Registered Student Organization from Fiscal
- .18 Probation, the Chair of the Operations Review Committee shall submit a memorandum explaining
- .19 the committee's actions to the Speaker of the Senate, Senate President Pro Tempore, CRT Chair, FAO
- .20 Chair, the Student Body President, SGA Comptroller, and the A&SF Business Office.
- .21 **D. Upon the Operations Review Committee placing an individual or Registered Student**
- .22 **Organization on Fiscal Probation the Chair of the Operations Review Committee shall contact**
- .23 **the individual or Registered Student Organization notifying them of their Fiscal Probation and**
- .24 **the opportunity for a hearing.**
- .25 ~~E. An individual or Registered Student Organization may be placed on Fiscal Probation by a~~
- .26 ~~majority vote of the Student Senate or by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Operations Review~~
- .27 ~~Committee for one (1) calendar year or until the individual's or Registered Student~~
- .28 ~~Organization's circumstance has been reviewed in accordance with current Operations Review~~
- .29 ~~Committee Fiscal Probation Policy.~~
- .30 ~~F. The Student Senate may release an individual or Registered Student Organization from Fiscal~~
- .31 ~~Probation with a majority vote.~~
- .32 ~~G. The Operations Review Committee may release a Registered Student Organization from Fiscal~~
- .33 ~~Probation with a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the committee. The Student Senate may overturn such a~~
- .34 ~~decision with a majority vote.~~
- .35 ~~G. Individuals or Registered Student Organizations on Fiscal Probation for a period of more than four~~
- .36 ~~(4) school weeks will have their probationary status automatically rescinded. Should an~~
- .37 ~~organization's probation status be rescinded in this manner, the Chair of the Operations Review~~
- .38 ~~Committee shall submit a memorandum to the Speaker of the Senate, Senate President Pro Tempore,~~
- .39 ~~CRT Chair, FAO Chair, Student Body President, SGA Comptroller, and A&SF Business Office~~
- .40 ~~notifying them of the change in status.~~
- .41 **H. The Chair of the Operations Review Committee may be established as the designated speaker**
- .42 **for the individual, as deemed necessary or requested, if the individual cannot attend and once**
- .43 **all pertinent information regarding the matter has been given to the Chair.**
- .44 ~~H. During the last Senate session of the probation period, the Operations Review Committee Chair must~~


.45 notify the Student Senate of the status of the individual or Registered Student Organization on Fiscal
.46 Probation, and, at that time, give the Operations Review Committee's recommendation as to whether
.47 the individual or Registered Student Organization should be placed on a second period of Fiscal
.48 Probation, whether to suspend financial authorization privileges, or whether to release the
.49 organization from fiscal probation. The Student Senate shall vote on the appropriate course of action,
.50 and it must pass by a majority vote.

- .51 **I. The Chair of the Operations Review Committee may be established as the designated speaker**
.52 **for the Registered Student Organization, as deemed necessary or requested, if an authorized**
.53 **officer cannot attend and once all pertinent information regarding the matter has been given**
.54 **to the Chair.**
- .55 ~~I. The Student Body President and/or Student Government Comptroller may submit a formal written~~
.56 ~~recommendation to the Student Senate Operations Review Committee suggesting the placement of~~
.57 ~~an individual or Registered Student Organization on fiscal probation.~~
- .58 **J. Individuals or Registered Student Organizations whom have failed to make contact with the**
.59 **Operations Review Committee within one (1) calendar year will have their probationary status**
.60 **reviewed by the Operations Review Committee where an extension of their probationary**
.61 **status may be granted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Operations Review Committee.**
