- .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of the Young Investors Club is to improve members understanding of investment
- .03 strategies and portfolio management; while engaging members in an interactive investing environment;
- .04 **WHEREAS**, Young Investors Club currently has 80 active, dues-paying members;
- .05 **WHEREAS**, Young Investors Club members pay an annual membership fee of \$50.00 or \$30.00 per semester;
- .06 **WHEREAS**, The International Traders Expo is one of the largest financial conferences in the world with some of
- .07 the most highly respected financial professionals in attendance;
- .08 **WHEREAS**, The International Traders Expo will be held at the Caesars Palace Hotel in Las Vegas, NV;
- .09 **WHEREAS**, Members of the Young Investors Club who attend the International Traders Expo will gain an
- .10 incredible amount of knowledge concerning financial markets, which will be brought back to University of Central
- .11 Florida (UCF) and shared with members of the UCF community;
- .12 **WHEREAS**, Members will serve as UCF ambassadors when interacting with financial professionals, providing

- .14 **WHEREAS**, Young Investors Club will be lodging at the Aria Resort in Las Vegas, NV; and

.28 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That no funds be spent on hotel;


.29 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That all unspent funds revert back to their originating account by January 5, 2015;

.32 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That Young Investors Club completes a post-travel form and returns it to the


.33 Operations Review Committee (ORC) by January 5, 2015, as a condition of receiving funding.

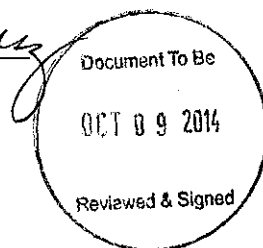
