[Funding for 15 Members of Student Personnel Association to attend the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators Conference in Baltimore, MD from March 11-19, 2014]

- .01 **WHEREAS**, Student Personnel Association (SPA) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1996;
- .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of SPA is to provide undergraduate and graduate students with the opportunity to collaborate with others who are interested in student affairs at a college or university;
- .03 **WHEREAS**, SPA currently has 22 active, dues-paying members;
- .04 **WHEREAS**, Members pay dues of \$20.00 per fall and spring semester, and \$5.00 per summer semester;
- .05 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of attending the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators Conference (NASPA) is to provide an opportunity for SPA members to access information and resources in a specific subject matter that pertains to the student affairs profession and come together through common interests in ways that support the NASPA mission, vision, and goals;
- .06 **WHEREAS**, Attendees will be educated through the use of technology and by way of face-to-face meetings, workshops, and conferences;
- .07 **WHEREAS**, There are 25 different knowledge communities at this conference;
- .08 **WHEREAS**, SPA members will be lodging at Hyatt Regency Baltimore in Baltimore, MD; and
- .09 **WHEREAS**, Student Personnel Association received \$0.00 in the 2013-2014 Activity and Service Fee Budget;

THEREFORE, BE IT

ENACTED, by the Forty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$5,809.60 be allocated to Student Personnel Association from the Registration and Travel Account (7140-0007) according to the following breakdown:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That no funds be spent on Registration for Conference and Registration for Placement Exchange;

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all unspent funds revert back to their originating account by April 22, 2014; and

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Student Personnel Association completes a post-travel form and returns it to the Operations Review Committee (ORC) by April 22, 2014, as a condition of receiving funding.
