
.01 **WHEREAS**, Collegiate National Association for Music Educators (CNAfME) mission is to increase knowledge, interest, and
 .02 productivity in all areas of music education through chapter programs and community outreach programs;
 .03 **WHEREAS**, CNAfME currently has 60 active, dues-paying members;
 .04 **WHEREAS**, CNAfME members pay dues of \$65.00 per year;
 .05 **WHEREAS**, CNAfME will be working with local businesses to raise funds for this conference;
 .06 **WHEREAS**, The Florida Music Educators Association Professional Development Conference contains workshops and resources
 .07 for future and practicing music teachers;
 .08 **WHEREAS**, The Florida Music Educators Association Professional Development Conference will provide a clinic that focuses
 .09 on technology and developing creativity in students;
 .10 **WHEREAS**, CNAfME members will be attending sessions with nationally recognized clinicians presenting technology and
 .11 current trends in music education, which contributes to the goal of providing the best undergraduate education available in
 .12 Florida;
 .13 **WHEREAS**, CNAfME members will learn about current research topics in music education, experience exemplary performances
 .14 and classroom demonstrations, and observe nationally recognized conductors working with all-state ensembles;
 .15 **WHEREAS**, CNAfME members who attend the conference will also have opportunities to share their experiences with other
 .16 members at spring program meetings and at other opportunities that present themselves;
 .17 **WHEREAS**, The Florida Music Educators Association Professional Development Conference is recognized along with Texas
 .18 and New York as one of the largest and most prestigious state music conferences;
 .19 **WHEREAS**, CNAfME will be lodging at the Westin Tampa Harbour Island in Tampa, FL; and
 .20 **WHEREAS**, Collegiate National Association for Music Educators received \$0.00 in the 2013-2014 Activity and Service Fee
 .21 Budget;

THEREFORE, BE IT

ENACTED, by the Forty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$3,028.80 be allocated to Florida Music Educators Association Professional Development Conference from the Registration and Travel Account (7140-0007) according to the following breakdown:


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That no funds be spent on Registration;
