[Funding for American Society for Engineering Education to host events at Engineering Week at the University of Central Florida from February 17-21, 2014]


.01 **WHEREAS**, American Society for Engineering Education (ASEE) has been a Registered Student Organization since 2003;  
 .02 **WHEREAS**, ASEE is committed to furthering education in engineering and computer science; This mission is accomplished by organizing,  
 .03 engaging, and informing students about programs and events of the College of Engineering and Computer Science; We will also act as a  
 .04 medium for which students can voice their opinions, suggestions, and requests on various matters to the administration of the College of  
 .05 Engineering and Computer Science; The Society seeks to encourage local, national, and international communication and collaboration;  
 .06 promote professional interaction and lifelong learning; recognize outstanding contributions of individuals and organizations; encourage youth  
 .07 to pursue studies and careers in engineering and computer science; and influence the recruitment and retention of young faculty and  
 .08 underrepresented groups;  
 .09 **WHEREAS**, ASEE currently has 15 active, dues-paying members,  
 .10 **WHEREAS**, ASEE members pay dues of \$5.00 per semester;  
 .11 **WHEREAS**, Engineering Week (E-Week) is a national, week-long celebration focusing on the contributions that engineers and computer  
 .12 scientists make to the world;  
 .13 **WHEREAS**, E-Week is a college-wide event that focuses on engineering and computer science skills, while educating the public on  
 .14 contributions of these professionals and fostering a community of camaraderie along with competition;  
 .15 **WHEREAS**, There will also be opportunities at E-Week for students within and external to the college to network with local industry  
 .16 partners;  
 .17 **WHEREAS**, E-Week allows students the opportunity to work together as a community to plan together the events and gain valuable  
 .18 leadership and volunteer experience;  
 .19 **WHEREAS**, ASEE will be hosting the CECS Club Showcase on February 17, 2014 and the Engineers Fair on February 19, 2014 as part of  
 the week of events;  
 .21 **WHEREAS**, E-Week will be held in the Engineering II and Harris Corporation Engineering Center Atriums and other locations throughout  
 .22 the campus; and  
 .23 **WHEREAS**, American Society for Engineering Education received \$0.00 in the 2013-2014 Activity and Service Fee Budget;

 .25 **THEREFORE, BE IT**


.26 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$3,080.00 be allocated to American Society for
