[Funding for National Organization for the Reform of Marijuana Laws to host the Spring Speaker Series in the Student Union Key West Ballroom]

.01 **WHEREAS**, National Organization for the Reform of Marijuana Laws (NORML) has been a Registered Student Organization
 .02 since 2001;
 .03 **WHEREAS**, The mission of NORML is to create awareness about marijuana laws and their relation to constitutional rights on
 .04 and around UCF in order to help bring about the eventual decriminalization of the possession, use, and cultivation of cannabis;
 .05 **WHEREAS**, NORML members pay dues of \$20.00 per semester or \$30.00 per year;
 .06 **WHEREAS**, NORML currently has 47 active, dues-paying members;
 .07 **WHEREAS**, The Spring Speaker Series is to further our mission while engaging students with honorable speakers such, as the
 .08 founder of National NORML and the executive director of National NORML, while gaining invaluable knowledge about
 .09 writing marijuana legislation;
 .10 **WHEREAS**, People will be listening to the guest speakers and learning about the direction the marijuana movement is taking
 .11 in 2014;
 .12 **WHEREAS**, These events will bring education and consciousness to the UCF community and hopefully instill a sense of
 .13 activism in anyone who attends;
 .14 **WHEREAS**, All three speakers have previously worked with NORML for other events; and
 .15 **WHEREAS**, National Organization for the Reform of Marijuana Laws received \$1,000.00 via FAO Allocation 45-105 and
 .16 \$99.91 via FAO Allocation 45-116, \$3,770.00 via Bill 45-126, \$3,120.00 via Bill 46-01, and \$0.00 in the 2013-2014 Activity
 and Service Fee Budget;

 .19 **THEREFORE, BE IT**

.20 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$2,695.00 be allocated to National
 .21 Organization for the Reform of Marijuana Laws from the Senate Working Fund (7140-0007) according to the following
