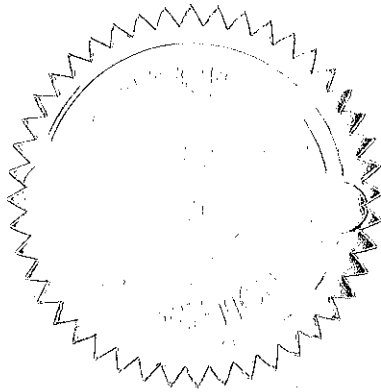

- .01 **WHEREAS**, Korean Student Association (KSA) has been a Registered Student Organization since 2006;  
.02 **WHEREAS**, KSA's mission is to provide a unifying entity which bring together students of Korean descent and  
.03 interest, while focusing on spreading awareness through educational programs and events about the unique culture  
.04 of Korea;  
.05 **WHEREAS**, KSA has 25 active, dues-paying members;  
.06 **WHEREAS**, KSA members pay dues of \$15.00 annually;  
.07 **WHEREAS**, KSA holds numerous cultural events on campus such as Chuseok, Hangul Day, Tae Kwon Do Demo  
.08 Knight, Seonal, KSA Birthday, Kimbap, and Kimchi workshop;  
.09 **WHEREAS**, KSA has collaborated with Chinese American Student Association (CASA) for the past six years to  
.10 host one of the largest events of the year;  
.11 **WHEREAS**, Several Registered Student Organizations and local organizations have participated in the  
.12 KSA/CASA Block Party every year;  
.13 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of KSA/CASA Block Party is to provide the UCF student body with an opportunity to  
.14 discover and engage in authentic Korean and Chinese cultures through entertaining performances, fun games, food,  
.15 music, and prizes; and  
.16 **WHEREAS**, Korean Student Association received \$0.00 in the 2013-2014 Activity & Service Fee budget;

.21 breakdown:


