.01 **WHEREAS**, American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA) has been a Registered Student Organization since  
 .02 1989;  
 .03 **WHEREAS**, AIAA's mission is to broaden the horizons of students interested in aerospace engineering and aid their futures in  
 .04 aerospace engineering by bridging the gap between students and the industry;  
 .05 **WHEREAS**, AIAA currently has 160 active, dues-paying members;  
 .06 **WHEREAS**, AIAA members pay dues of \$20.00 annually;  
 .07 **WHEREAS**, AIAA was awarded Student Organization Officer of the Year for the 2011-2012 academic year from Knights of  
 .08 the Round Table;  
 .09 **WHEREAS**, AIAA's Cubesat Project encompasses weekly classes beginning in August 2013 that run until May 31, 2014, with  
 .10 an expected final event on May 31, 2014, all within the University of Central Florida (UCF) Orlando Campus; and  
 .11 **WHEREAS**, American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics received \$964.14 via FAO Allocation 45-113, \$1,000.00 via  
 .12 FAO Allocation 46-24, \$100.00 via FAO Allocation 46-67, \$970.71 via FAO Allocation 46-68, \$5,002.99 via Senate Bill 46-24,  
 .13 \$3,895.75 via Senate Bill 46-40, \$1,500.00 via CRT Allocation 46-227, and \$0.00 in the 2013-2014 Activity and Service Fee  
 .14 Budget;



 .16 **THEREFORE, BE IT**


.17 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$1,090.77 be allocated to American  
 .18 Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics from the Senate Working Fund (7140-0007) according to the following breakdown:

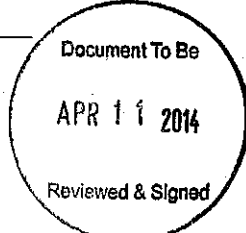
