- .01 **WHEREAS**, The American Society of Highway Engineers (ASHE) has been a Registered Student Organization since 2003;
- .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of the American Society of Highway Engineers is to provide a forum for members and partners of the
- .03 highway industry that supports education, innovation, and fellowship; promoting a safe and efficient highway system;
- .04 **WHEREAS**, ASHE currently has 41 active members;
- .05 **WHEREAS**, The Transportation Research Board (TRB) Annual Meeting provides a variety of workshops and information
- .06 sessions related to the transportation industry;
- .07 **WHEREAS**, Students and professionals from around the world attend the TRB Annual Meeting to present and hear the latest
- .08 research in transportation;
- .09 **WHEREAS**, ASHE will have twenty (20) research papers presented at the TRB Annual Meeting;
- .10 **WHEREAS**, ASHE will be lodging at the Donovan House Hotel in Washington, DC; and
- .11 **WHEREAS**, The American Society of Highway Engineers received \$0.00 in the 2014-2015 Activity and Service Fee Budget;


.13 **THEREFORE, BE IT**


.14 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Seventh Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$8,699.25 be allocated to American Society of Highway Engineers from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

.19	Lodging (\$343.50 x 3 nights x 7 rooms)	\$7,213.50
.20	Airfare (\$275.00 x 21 members)	\$5,775.00
.21	Additional Travel (\$50.00 x 21 members)	\$1,050.00
.22	Total Cost	\$17,398.50
.23	Total American Society of Highway Engineers Contribution	\$8,699.25
.24	<b>Total Senate Contribution</b>	<b>\$8,699.25</b>

- .26 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That no funds be spent on Additional Travel and Registration;
- .27 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That all unspent funds revert back to their originating account by February 16, 2015; and
- .28 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That American Society of Highway Engineers completes a Post-Funding Form and returns it to
- .29 the Operations Review Committee (ORC) by February 16, 2015, as a condition of receiving funding.
