[Funding for 16 members of Pre-Medical American Medical Student Association to attend the AMSA Convention and Exposition in Washington, D.C., from February 26 - March 1, 2015]

- .01 **WHEREAS**, Pre-Medical American Medical Student Association (Pre-Med AMSA) has been a Registered Student
- .02 Organization since 1992;
- .03 **WHEREAS**, The mission of Pre-Med AMSA is to prepare Pre-Med students to become knowledgeable and well-rounded
- .04 medical school candidates through scholarship, networking, philanthropy and community partnership;
- .05 **WHEREAS**, Pre-Med AMSA currently has 250 members, of which over 150 pay dues;
- .06 **WHEREAS**, Pre-Med AMSA new members pay dues of \$75.00 and returning members pay dues of \$35.00 annually;
- .07 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of the trip is to stay current on today's most critical healthcare advocacy issues, take part in
- .08 forums focused on specialty healthcare topics, develop leadership skills, get involved with interesting committees and
- .09 projects, and gain invaluable insight from the finest physicians, public health officials, community activists, educators,
- .10 associations, and non-profit executives in the health care industry;
- .11 **WHEREAS**, The goal of the convention is to educate physicians in training in the areas of Careers and Public Development,
- .12 Advocacy, Public Health, and International Health;
- .13 **WHEREAS**, Pre-Med AMSA will be lodging at the Hyatt Regency Crystal City in Arlington, VA; and
- .14 **WHEREAS**, Pre-Medical American Medical Student Association received \$2,312.00 via CRT Allocation 46-614, \$992.00
- .15 via FAO Allocation 46-140, and \$0.00 in the 2014-2015 Activity and Service Fee Budget;

THEREFORE, BE IT

.18 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Seventh Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$5,728.00 be allocated to Pre-

.19 Medical American Medical Student Association from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following

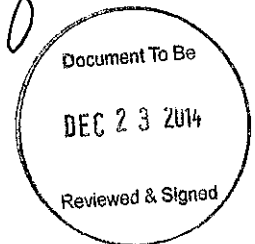
