- .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of SWE is to stimulate women to achieve full potential in careers as engineers and leaders, expand
- .03 the image of the engineering profession as a positive force in improving the quality of life, and demonstrate the value of
- .04 diversity;
- .05 **WHEREAS**, SWE members pay dues of \$20.00 annually;
- .06 **WHEREAS**, SWE currently has 60 active, dues-paying active members;
- .07 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of this conference is to attend creative and professional workshops and network with business
- .08 professionals;
- .09 **WHEREAS**, Attendants will be participating in workshops, attending guest speaker presentations, developing professional


.17 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Seventh Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$6,954.00 be allocated to the Society



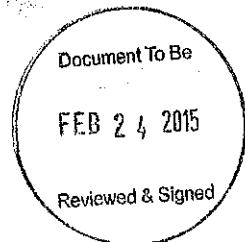
