.01 **WHEREAS**, Student Professionals for Industrial Organizational Psychology (SPIOP) has been a Registered Student
 .02 Organization since 2008;
 .03 **WHEREAS**, The mission of SPIOP is to promote graduate and undergraduate students' understanding and involvement within
 .04 the field of Industrial/Organizational Psychology;
 .05 **WHEREAS**, SPIOP members pay dues of \$10.00 per semester;
 .06 **WHEREAS**, SPIOP currently has 38 active, dues-paying members;
 .07 **WHEREAS**, SPIOP members who attend the conference will present research, bring back knowledge to the University of
 .08 Central Florida (UCF), attend seminars, learn new research methods, network with professionals, and collaborate with other
 .09 schools;
 .10 **WHEREAS**, SPIOP will be lodging at the Hilton Anaheim in Anaheim, CA; and
 .11 **WHEREAS**, Student Professionals for Industrial Organizational Psychology received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds
 .12 during the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year;

.13 **THEREFORE, BE IT**
 .14 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Eighth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida \$11,080.00 be allocated to Student
 .15 Professionals for Industrial Organizational Psychology from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following
 .16 breakdown:

 .28 Form and returns it to the Operations Review Committee (ORC) by May 23, 2016, as a condition of receiving funding.

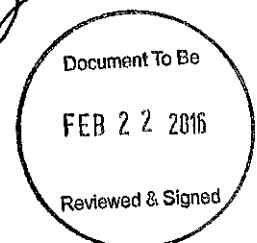
