[Funding for 31 members of Student Physical Therapy Association to travel to the Combined Sections Meeting in San Antonio, Texas, from February 15 - 18, 2017]

.01 WHEREAS, Student Physical Therapy Association (SPTA) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1995;
.02 WHEREAS, The mission of SPTA is to promote the awareness of the physical therapy program on the campus and in the
.03 community, facilitate the growth and wellness of physical therapy students, and provide volunteer services throughout the
.04 community thereby furthering continuing education of physical therapy students;
.05 WHEREAS, SPTA members pay dues of \$50.00 per semester or \$150.00 annually;
.06 WHEREAS, SPTA currently has 103 active, dues-paying members;
.07 WHEREAS, The purpose of the Combined Sections Meeting is to network with peers, practitioners, mentors and leaders; to
.08 explore career paths and meet future employers; to learn practical information outside of the classroom; to see the latest
.09 products and technologies; to survey research platforms and expand our body of knowledge;
.10 WHEREAS, Members will network with professionals, gain knowledge on new trends and technologies in the industry, and
.11 present their research;
.12 WHEREAS, Members will acquire relationships with 500 exhibiting companies, 11,000 physical therapists and assistants, and
.13 bring back new information and knowledge to the University of Central Florida and Orlando;
.14 WHEREAS, SPTA will be lodging at the Holiday Inn San Antonio-Riverwalk in San Antonio, Texas; and
.15 WHEREAS, Student Physical Therapy Association received \$4,765.53 via Senate Bill 48-103 in Activity and Service Fee
.16 Funds in the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year;

THEREFORE, BE IT

ENACTED, by the Forty-Ninth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$11,438.77 be allocated to Student Physical Therapy Association from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

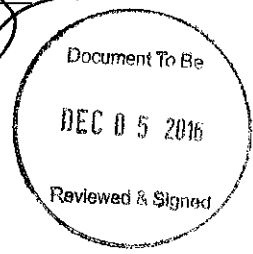
