- .01 **WHEREAS**, Spanish Graduate Association (SaGA) has been a Registered Student Organization since 2000;
- .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of SaGA shall be to foster the growth of Spanish graduate students and any student who may be interested
- .03 in Spanish Language and Culture through an academic and professional environment;
- .04 **WHEREAS**, SaGA members pay dues of \$10.00 per semester;
- .05 **WHEREAS**, SaGA currently has 16 active, dues-paying members;
- .06 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of the Annual Colloquium is to promote collaboration and networking among students in the field of
- .07 Spanish literature and linguistics, and to help distribute and present research in the fields of Spanish language, literature, and culture;
- .08 **WHEREAS**, The Annual Colloquium will bring together a significant number of professors, students, teaching professionals, and
- .09 researchers who will learn about the University of Central Florida (UCF) and its graduate programs in the field of Spanish and
- .10 teaching English to speakers of other languages;
- .11 **WHEREAS**, The Annual Colloquium will promote the discussion of educational and job opportunities for undergraduate and graduate
- .12 students;
- .13 **WHEREAS**, SaGA has hosted this Colloquium successfully for the past sixteen years; and
- .14 **WHEREAS**, Spanish Graduate Association received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year;

THEREFORE, BE IT

ENACTED, by the Forty-Ninth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$2,835.00 be allocated to Spanish Graduate Association from the Senate Working Fund according to the following breakdown:

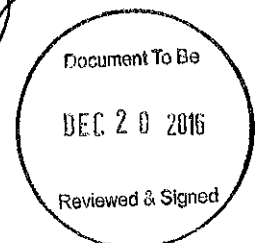
