.01 **WHEREAS**, Caribbean Students' Association (CSA) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1985;
 .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of CSA is to provide an orientation for Caribbean students entering the University of Central
 .03 Florida. At the same time, we hope to stimulate interaction between Caribbean students and students of other cultures;
 .04 **WHEREAS**, CSA members pay dues of \$30.00 annually or \$20.00 per semester;
 .05 **WHEREAS**, CSA currently has 180 active, dues-paying members;
 .06 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of the 15th Annual Ms. & 9th Annual Mr. CSA UCF Pageant is to showcase the many facets of the
 .07 Caribbean culture and seek out representatives that will bring that to the forefront of the University of Central Florida (UCF)
 .08 and Greater Orlando community;
 .09 **WHEREAS**, Students attending this event will learn about important figures and events that has greatly shaped the various
 .10 countries associated with the Caribbean and the impact on the rest of the world. Also, attendees will learn about various cultural
 .11 clothing and the purpose and history behind the clothing;
 .12 **WHEREAS**, CSA has hosted this event for 15 years with over 300 student attendees; and
 .13 **WHEREAS**, CSA received \$1,000.00 via FAO Allocation 49-61 and \$1,000.00 via FAO Allocation 49-150 in Activity and
 .14 Service Fee Funds in the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year;

 .16 **THEREFORE, BE IT**
 .17 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Ninth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$3,575.00 be allocated to Caribbean
 .18 Students' Association from the Senate Working Fund according to the following breakdown:

 .33 Operations Review Committee (ORC) by May 8, 2017, as a condition of receiving funding.

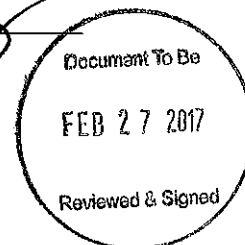
