[Funding for the American Society of Mechanical Engineers to host the Internal Robotics Competition at the Atrium at Engineering Building II, on April 22, 2017]

.01 **WHEREAS**, American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1970;
 .02 **WHEREAS**, The mission of ASME is the advancement and dissemination of the theory and practice of mechanical
 .03 engineering, the presentation of proper perspective of engineering work, and the opportunity to meet and become acquainted
 .04 with fellow students and personnel working in industry;
 .05 **WHEREAS**, ASME members pay dues of \$20.00 annually;
 .06 **WHEREAS**, ASME currently has 239 active, dues-paying members;
 .07 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of the Internal Robotics Competition is to allow students that did not have enough time to work with
 .08 the Student Design Competition to compete with robots that they created over the semester with a smaller budget;
 .09 **WHEREAS**, Students will learn how to work with robotic components both mechanically and electronically, giving them skills
 .10 that they can use in the future in their fields; and
 .11 **WHEREAS**, The American Society of Mechanical Engineers received \$3,000.00 via CRT Allocation 48-705, \$971.50 via
 .12 FAO Allocation 49-15, \$7,500.00 via Senate Bill 49-19, and \$3,037.50 via Senate Bill 49-20 in Activity and Service Fee Funds
 .13 in the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year;



 .15 **THEREFORE, BE IT**


.16 **ENACTED**, by the Forty-Ninth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$797.80 be allocated to the American
