[Funding for the American Society of Civil Engineers to construct the Concrete Canoe for the American Society of Civil Engineers Regional Concrete Canoe Competition in Gainesville, Florida on March 1-3, 2018]

1 **WHEREAS**, The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) has been a Registered Student Organization since
 2 1972;
 3 **WHEREAS**, The mission of ASCE is to build the foundation of tomorrow by advancing the spirit of professionalism
 4 and creativity among their members, by stimulating interest in civil engineering, by contributing to the needs of their
 5 community and society, and by encouraging students to become more involved as leaders;
 6 **WHEREAS**, ASCE currently has 60 active dues-paying members;
 7 **WHEREAS**, ASCE members pay dues of \$30.00 annually;
 8 **WHEREAS**, Groups are required to construct a Concrete Canoe to attend the 2018 Southeast Student Conference;
 9 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of the conference is to give the University of Central Florida (UCF) engineering students
 10 the opportunity to use knowledge learned in classes in a hands on experience as they compete with 24 other
 11 universities in 14 engineering competitions;
 12 **WHEREAS**, ASCE holds biweekly chapter meetings as well as community service events multiple times each year;
 13 **WHEREAS**, The Concrete Canoe Team placed 7th overall amongst 24 universities in the 2014 conference allowing
 14 for improvement;
 15 **WHEREAS**, ASCE Concrete Canoe has been effectively presented to numerous potential corporate donors;
 16 **WHEREAS**, ASCE Concrete Canoe has numerous fund raising events scheduled such as restaurant-proceeds
 17 fundraisers and engineering professional package sales;
 18 **WHEREAS**, ASCE requests funding to procure the below listed materials for the construction of their Concrete
 19 Canoe for the 2018 Southeast Student Conference; and
 20 **WHEREAS**, American Society of Civil Engineers received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2017-
 21 2018 Fiscal Year;

 23 **THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fiftieth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$4,394.15
 24 be allocated to American Society of Civil Engineers from the Senate Working Fund according to the following


