[Funding for Saxophone Collegium to host the Central Florida SaxFest in the UCF Rehearsal Hall on April 7, 2018]


1 **WHEREAS**, Saxophone Collegium has been a Registered Student Organization (RSO) since 2002;
 2 **WHEREAS**, The mission of Saxophone Collegium is to provide leadership, community involvement, and
 3 educational opportunities for its members and to promote student interest and involvement in the Saxophone
 4 Collegium's sponsored program meetings and festivals. In addition, Saxophone Collegium provides UCF students
 5 and community members the opportunity to come in contact with world renowned saxophonists through events such
 6 as the annual Central Florida SaxFest. The organization also provides musical enrichment through performances
 7 both on and off campus;
 8 **WHEREAS**, Saxophone Collegium members pay dues of \$10.00 annually;
 9 **WHEREAS**, Saxophone Collegium currently has 20 active members;
 10 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of the Central Florida SaxFest is to provide UCF students and local community members
 11 the opportunity to come in contact with world renowned saxophonists. This event also increases the visibility of
 12 UCF's School of Music through community participation;
 13 **WHEREAS**, The Central Florida SaxFest, which is in its 19th year, gives UCF students an opportunity to hear and
 14 learn from internationally renowned saxophonists;
 15 **WHEREAS**, The Central Florida SaxFest has an expected attendance of 75 student attendees; and
 16 **WHEREAS**, Saxophone Collegium received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year;



 18 **THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED** by the Fiftieth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that
 19 \$3,000.00 be allocated to Saxophone Collegium from the Senate Working Fund according to the following breakdown:

 29 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That Saxophone Collegium completes a Post-Funding Form and returns it to the
 30 Operations Review Committee (ORC) by May 11, 2018 as a condition of receiving funding; and
 31 **BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That Saxophone Collegium completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form and
 32 returns it to ORC by May 11, 2018 as a condition of receiving funding.
