[Funding for African Students Organization to host the ASO Showcase in the UCF Live Oak Ballroom on March 29, 2018]


1 **WHEREAS**, African Students Organization (ASO) has been a Registered Student Organization (RSO) since 2014;
 2 **WHEREAS**, The mission of ASO is to promote African culture to the UCF campus and the surrounding community through
 3 dance, music, poetry, and more. ASO seeks to be a social, academic, and cultural part of the college experience for students,
 4 and welcomes anyone with an interest learning more about Africa;
 5 **WHEREAS**, ASO members pay dues of \$15.00 per semester and \$30.00 annually;
 6 **WHEREAS**, African Students Organization currently has 120 active, dues paying members;
 7 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of the ASO Showcase is to showcase African culture to the students of UCF, through a variety of
 8 activities like dance, music, fashion, poetry, etc.;
 9 **WHEREAS**, ASO hopes that by taking part in this event, the UCF faculty, staff, and students get to experience and enjoy the
 10 show and expression of African culture. ASO also believes that this event will provide the UCF community an opportunity to
 11 learn about the African diaspora, its beauty and issues that face the African community, and how we as millennials are trying to
 12 overcome them;
 13 **WHEREAS**, The ASO Showcase has an expected attendance of 230 student attendees; and
 14 **WHEREAS**, African Students Organization received \$1,000.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year;


