
- 1 WHEREAS, Society of Automotive Engineers has been a Registered Student Organization since 2002;
- 2 WHEREAS, The mission of SAE is to represent UCF through positive participation in automotive engineering
- 3 collegiate design competitions, supporting the community, and achieving more international recognition;
- 4 WHEREAS, SAE members pay dues of \$50.00 annually or \$30.00 per semester;
- 5 WHEREAS, SAE currently has 120 active members;
- 6 WHEREAS, The purpose of the Formula SAE Competition is to be a fortification and enhancement to the
- 7 education of student members, while positively representing and furthering the reputation of UCF through
- 8 competition(s). The organization intends to accomplish this goal through building, designing, and competing with
- 9 student constructed vehicle(s) within the rules set forth by the Society of Automotive Engineers;
- 10 WHEREAS, This event will teach upcoming engineers the skills they need for the future to be successful engineers
- 11 and to teach real world skills not taught in the classroom; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Society of Automotive Engineers has received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2018-
- 13 2019 Fiscal Year;



17 following breakdown:

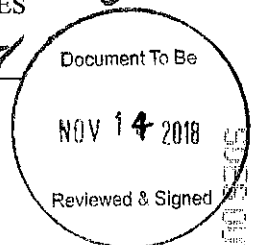
