[Funding for Knight Riders Motorcycle Club to host the Knight Riders Spring 2019 Track weekend in the Jennings, Florida on March 16, 2019]

1 **WHEREAS**, Knight Riders Motorcycle Club (Knight Riders) has been a Registered Student Organization (RSO)
2 since 7/8/2015;
3 **WHEREAS**, The mission of the Knight Riders Motorcycle Club is to bring unity among motorcycle riders and
4 enthusiasts in the UCF community;
5 **WHEREAS**, Knight Riders members pay dues of \$20 per semester or \$40 annually;
6 **WHEREAS**, Knight Riders Motorcycle Club currently has 41 active, dues paying members;
7 **WHEREAS**, The purpose of the Knight Riders Spring 2019 Track weekend is to Track Days are the most exciting,
8 fun and effective way to improve your riding skills. You will learn how to corner and brake with a lot more
9 confidence and control. Track Days are held on a closed course (racetrack), which means you learn in a safe
10 environment and at real-world speeds. Learning on a racetrack allows you to ride freely and concentrate on and
11 advancing your skill level without the typical hazards faced on the street, such as potholes, sand, turtles, snakes,
12 uneven ground, unexpected corners etc. Many types of machines at our regular track day events. While most ride
13 sport bikes, there are also those who ride Tourers, Adventure bikes, and Sport Tourers. There are even special Non-
14 Sportbike Days. It's one of the best investments in fun and skill development money can buy;
15 **WHEREAS**, While parking lot courses have their place, riding your bike on a track will let you practice riding
16 skills at real-world speeds without the normal distractions found on public roads (like cars, sand, cops, etc).
17 Classroom sessions are included in the price of your day where you will benefit from discussions and
18 demonstrations of advanced riding technique that you can then try on the track. The fact that you visit each corner
19 several times a day allows you to perfect your technique without the changing variables found on the street. These
20 techniques are transferable to street riding;
21 **WHEREAS**, The Knight Riders Spring 2019 Track weekend has an expected attendance of 54 student attendees;

23 **WHEREAS**, Knight Riders Motorcycle Club received \$2,971.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2018-
24 2019 Fiscal Year;



28 breakdown:


