University of Central Florida Forty-Seventh Student Body Senate Resolution 47-30

[Changes to Senate Rule One: The Senate Executive Committee]

WHEREAS. Senate Rules and Procedures require constant updates and revisions to best serve the Student Government

WHEREAS, Senate Rule One: The Senate Executive Committee contains numerous typographical and syntax errors; and WHEREAS, The proposed changes to Senate Rule One will help clarify the roles and responsibilities of the Senate Executive Committee by updating confusing phrasing and removing errors;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Forty-Seventh Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Senate Rule One be changed to reflect the following:

1.01 Senate Executive Committee Structure of the Senate Executive Committee

- A. Members: The Senate Executive Committee shall be comprised of the Senate President Pro Tempore, the Deputy Pro Temporesthe Deputy Pro Tempore of Senate Operations and Appropriations, the Deputy Pro Tempore of Legislative Affairs, the legislative Assistants the External Legislative Assistant, the Internal Legislative Assistant, the standing and ad hoc committee Chairs, the Vice Chairs, and the Speaker of the Senate, as an ex-officio member.
 - 1. All standing committee and ad hoc committee Chairs shall have voting and debating powers.
 - The Senate President Pro Tempore shall have all voting and debating privileges.
 - 3. Vice Chairs shall have all debating Pprivileges and, in the absence of the Chair, then the Vice Chairs shall have voting privileges.
 - 4. Deputy Pro Tempores The Deputy Pro Tempore of Senate Operations and Appropriations and the Deputy Pro Tempore of Legislative Affairs shall have all debating priviledges and, in the absence of the Senate President Pro Tempore, The Deputy Pro Tempore of Senate Operations and Appropriations shall have voting privileges. If the Deputy Pro Tempore of Senate Operations and Appropriations also absent, the Deputy Pro Tempore of Legislative Affairs shall have voting privileges.
 - The Internal and/or External Legislative Assistants shall have debating privileges.
- B. The Speaker of the Senate shall be the Chair, and the Senate President Pro Tempore shall be the Vice
- C. The Senate Executive Committee shall meet, as called by the Speaker of the Senate, the Senate President Pro Tempore, or by majority vote of the Committee.

The purpose of the Senate Executive Committee is: Roles and Responsibilities of the Senate Executive 1.02 Committee

- A. To represent the Student Senate in times of crisis and to present and argue the views of the Senate, as expressed by Senate resolutions.
- B. To facilitate communication between the officers of the Student Senate.

AUTHORIZING SIGNATURES

- C. To serve as an appellate avenue for Senate business, as provided for in the Senate Rules and Procedures.
- D. To expunge Senate meeting absences of Senate members, upon petition of the Senator in question, by majority vote of the Senate Executive Committee.
