[The 2016-2017 Operations Review Committee Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy]

.01 **WHEREAS**, The Operations Review Committee is responsible for creating an Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy;
.02 and

.03 **WHEREAS**, The Operations Review Committee hereby establishes this Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy based
.04 on recommendations from the Student Government Finance Office;

.06 **THEREFORE, BE IT**

.07 **RESOLVED**, by the Forty-Eighth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that the following
.08 policies be established for the use of the Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy by the Operations Review Committee
.09 and the Student Body Senate:

.11 1. Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who receive funding via a Student Senate
.12 Allocation or Bill shall automatically be placed on Fiscal Probation for one (1) calendar year
.13 upon reverting ~~ten percent (10%)~~ **twenty percent (20%)** or more of any one Senate Allocation
.14 or Bill.
- .15 2. During the Fiscal Probation Period for a reversion, the Operations Review Committee shall
.16 review the circumstances of the reversion and determine by a majority vote whether to apply
.17 the appropriate Funding Sanction.
- .18 3. If an Individual does not attend a scheduled Fiscal Review anytime during the one-calendar
.19 year of said probation, the Fiscal Probation will automatically be extended as long as the
.20 Individual is enrolled at the University of Central Florida or pending Fiscal Review.
- .21 4. If a Registered Student Organization does not attend a scheduled Fiscal Review anytime during
.22 the one-calendar year of said probation, the Fiscal Probation will automatically be extended for
.23 one (1) year, for up to four (4) years or pending Fiscal Review.
- .24 5. If a Registered Student Organization or Individual already subject to a Funding Sanction
.25 becomes subject to another Funding Sanction, they shall have their funding levels reduced as
.26 follows:
- .27 a) The current Funding Sanctions will remain in place for their specified
.28 duration ~~and the additional sanctioning will be based on the revised funding~~
.29 ~~cap. For example, stacking two thirty percent (30%) sanctions would result in~~
.30 ~~a total fifty one (51%) sanction: Thirty percent (30%) of one hundred percent~~
.31 ~~(100%) plus thirty percent (30%) of seventy percent (70%). This process will~~
.32 ~~continue for any number of additional sanctions and the additional sanction~~
.33 ~~will be added to the previous sanction. For example, two (2) thirty-five~~
.34 ~~percent (35%) sanctions will equal seventy percent (70%).~~
- .35 b) When one Funding Sanction expires, any additional sanctions still in existence
.36 will be readjusted to reflect the removal of the expired sanction.
- .37 c) **Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who receive two (2) or**
.38 **more Funding Sanctions within the time-frame of one calendar year, or**
.39 **receive Funding Sanctions in consecutive years, will be required to attend**
.40 **an educational workshop hosted by the President Pro Tempore's office.**

6. Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who are subject to a Funding Sanction shall have their funding levels reduced as follows:
 - a) Fifteen percent (15%) for a reversion greater than or equal to ~~ten percent (10%)~~ **twenty percent (20%)** but less than fifty percent (50%).
 - b) Thirty percent (30%) for a reversion greater than or equal to fifty percent (50%) and less than or equal to one-hundred percent (100%).
 7. Funding Sanctions are active for one calendar year from the date of the Operations Review Committee's review of the circumstances of reversion.
 8. Funding Sanctions shall be applied to Senate Bills and Allocations as follows:
 - a) Funding Sanctions for Allocations shall be applied to the amount requested by the Registered Student Organization or Individual.
 - b) Funding Sanctions for Bills shall be applied to the Senate Contribution amount.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that to break this policy will require a two-thirds (2/3) vote of Operations Review Committee (ORC) or the Student Body Senate.
