[Updates to the 2017-2018 Operations Review Committee Fiscal Probation Policy]

.01 **WHEREAS,** The Operations Review Committee is responsible for creating an Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy; and
.02 **WHEREAS,** The Operations Review Committee hereby establishes this Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy based on
.03 recommendations from the Student Government Finance Office;

.05 ***THEREFORE, BE IT***

.06 **ENACTED,** by the Forty-Ninth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that the following policies be
.07 established for the use of the Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy by the Operations Review Committee and the Student
.08 Body Senate:

- .10 1. Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who receive funding via a Student Senate
.11 Allocation or Bill shall automatically be placed on Fiscal Probation until the Operations Review
.12 Committee dismisses the probation by a majority vote upon reverting twenty percent (20%) or more of
.13 any one Senate Allocation or Bill.
- .14 2. **Registered Student Organizations who receive funding via a Student Senate Bill shall**
.15 **automatically be placed on Fiscal Probation until the Operations Review Committee dismisses the**
.16 **probation by a majority vote upon failure to match at least ninety-five percent (95%) of the**
.17 **Senate's contribution from the organization's own funds.**
- .18 3. ~~2.~~ During the Fiscal Probation Period, the Operations Review Committee shall
.19 review the circumstances of the reversion or **failure to match funds** and determine by a majority vote
.20 whether to apply the appropriate Funding Sanction.
- .21 4. ~~3.~~ If an Individual does not attend a scheduled **Fiscal Review** ~~fiscal review~~ during the first four (4)
.22 regularly scheduled meetings of the Operation Review Committee, excluding committee caucus
.23 meetings, the committee reserves the right to apply the proper funding sanctions as defined in this
.24 policy.
- .25 5. ~~4.~~ If a Registered Student Organization or an Individual is sanctioned without attending a scheduled Fiscal
.26 Review within the first four (4) regular scheduled meetings of the Operation Review Committee, their
.27 Fiscal Probation period shall extend until the Registered Student Organization or Individual schedule a
.28 meeting with the President Pro Tempore's office and complete the Sanctioned Entity Informational
.29 Presentation.
- .30 6. ~~5.~~ If a Registered Student Organization or Individual already subject to a Funding Sanction
.31 becomes subject to another Funding Sanction, they shall have their funding levels reduced
.32 as follows:
 - .33 a) The current Funding Sanction will remain in place for their specified duration
.34 and the additional sanction will be added to the previous sanction. For
.35 example, two (2) thirty-five percent (~~30%~~ ~~35%~~) sanctions will equal **sixty seventy**
.36 **percent (60% ~~70%~~)**.
 - .37 b) When one Funding Sanction expires, any additional sanctions still in
.38 existence will be readjusted to reflect the removal of the expired sanction.
 - .39 c) Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who receive two (2) or more

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Funding Sanctions within the time-frame of one calendar year, or receive Funding Sanctions in consecutive years, will be required to attend an educational workshop hosted by the President Pro Tempore's office.

7. 6. Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who are subject to a Funding Sanction due to a reversion of funds shall have their funding levels reduced as follows:

- a) Fifteen percent (15%) for a reversion greater than or equal to twenty percent (20%) but less than fifty percent (50%).
- b) Thirty percent (30%) for a reversion greater than or equal to fifty percent (50%) and less than or equal to one-hundred percent (100%).

8. Registered Student Organizations who are subject to a Funding Sanction due to a failure to match the Senate's contribution shall have their funding levels reduced as follows:

- a) Sanction at the discretion of the committee for failure to contribute at least ninety-five percent (95%) of the Senate's contribution.
- b) Sanction at the discretion of the committee as well as suspension from Bill funding for one calendar year for failure to contribute at least eighty percent (80%) of the Senate's contribution.
- c) Sanction at the discretion of the committee as well as suspension from all funding for one calendar year for failure to contribute at least fifty percent (50%) of the Senate's contribution.


9. 8. Funding Sanctions are active for one calendar year from the date of the Operations Review Committee's review of the circumstances of the reversion or failure of contribution.


10. 9. Funding Sanctions shall be applied to Senate Bills and Allocations as follows:

- a) Funding Sanctions for Allocations shall be applied to the amount requested by the Registered Student Organization or Individual.
- b) Funding Sanctions for Bills shall be applied to the Senate Contribution amount.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that to break this policy will require a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Operations Review Committee or the Student Body Senate.
