

Fiftieth Student Body Senate
Resolution 50-53

(The 2018-2019 Operations Review & Sanctions Committee Fiscal Probation Policy)

- 1 **WHEREAS**, The Operations Review & Sanctions (ORS) Committee is responsible for creating an Automatic Fiscal
2 Probation Policy; and
3 **WHEREAS**, The ORS Committee hereby establishes this Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy based on
4 recommendations from the Student Government Finance Office;

6 **THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fiftieth Student **Body** Senate of the University of Central Florida
7 that the following policies be established for the use of the Automatic Fiscal Probation Policy by the ORS
8 Committee and the Student Body Senate:

10 1. Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who receive funding via a Student Senate Allocation or Bill shall
11 automatically be placed on Fiscal Probation until the ORS Committee dismisses the probation by a majority vote
12 upon reverting twenty percent (20%) or more of any one Senate Allocation or Bill.
13 2. Registered Student Organizations who receive funding via a Student Senate Bill shall automatically be placed on
14 Fiscal Probation until the ORS Committee dismisses the probation by a majority vote upon failure to match at
15 least ninety-five percent (95%) of the Student Body Senate's contribution from the organization's own funds.
16 3. During the Fiscal Probation Period, the ORS Committee shall review the circumstances of the reversion or failure
17 to match funds and determine by a majority vote whether to apply the appropriate Funding Sanction.
18 4. If an Individual does not attend a scheduled Fiscal Review during the first four (4) regularly scheduled meetings
19 of the ORS Committee, excluding committee caucus meetings, the committee reserves the right to apply the
20 proper funding sanctions as defined in this policy.
21 5. If a Registered Student Organization or an Individual is sanctioned without attending a scheduled Fiscal Review
22 within the first four (4) regular scheduled meetings of the Operation Review Committee, their Fiscal Probation
23 period shall extend until the Registered Student Organization or Individual schedule a meeting with the President
24 Pro Tempore's office and complete the Sanctioned Entity Informational Presentation.
25 6. If a Registered Student Organization or Individual already subject to a Funding Sanction becomes subject to
26 another Funding Sanction, they shall have their funding levels reduced as follows:
27 a) The current Funding Sanction will remain in place for their specified duration and the additional sanction
28 will be added to the previous sanction. For example, two (2) thirty percent (30%) sanctions will equal
29 sixty percent (60%).
30 b) When one Funding Sanction expires, any additional sanctions still in existence will be readjusted to
31 reflect the removal of the expired sanction.
32 c) Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who receive two (2) or more Funding Sanctions within
33 the time-frame of one calendar year, or receive Funding Sanctions in consecutive years, will be
34 required to attend an educational workshop hosted by the President Pro Tempore's office.
35 7. Registered Student Organizations or Individuals who are subject to a Funding Sanction due to a reversion of funds
36 shall have their funding levels reduced as follows:
37 a) Fifteen percent (15%) for a reversion greater than or equal to twenty percent (20%) but less than fifty
38 percent (50%).
39 b) Thirty percent (30%) for a reversion greater than or equal to fifty percent (50%) and less than or equal to
40 one-hundred percent (100%).
41 8. Registered Student Organizations who are subject to a Funding Sanction due to a failure to match the Student
42 Body Senate's contribution shall have their funding levels reduced as follows:
43 a) Sanction at the discretion of the committee for failure to contribute at least ninety-five percent (95%) of
44 the Student Body Senate's contribution.


- 45 b)Sanction at the discretion of the committee as well as suspension from Bill funding for one calendar year
46 for failure to contribute at least eighty percent (80%) of the Student Body Senate's contribution.
47 c)Sanction at the discretion of the committee as well as suspension from all funding for one calendar year
48 for failure to contribute at least fifty percent (50%) of the Student Body Senate's contribution.
49 9. Funding Sanctions are active for one calendar year from the date of the ORS Committee's review of the
50 circumstances of the reversion or failure of contribution.
51 10. Funding Sanctions shall be applied to Senate Bills and Allocations as follows:
52 a)Funding Sanctions for Allocations shall be applied to the amount requested by the Registered Student
53 Organization or Individual.
54 b)Funding Sanctions for Bills shall be applied to the Senate Contribution amount.
