[Updates to Senate Rule 1]

1 **WHEREAS**, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;
2 **WHEREAS**, Currently, DPTs, LAs, and Vice Chairs lack voting power on the Senate Exec Committee;
3 **WHEREAS**, This Resolution grants them voting powers without affecting quorum
4 **WHEREAS**, This Resolution will go into effect immediately;

6 **THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fiftieth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida
7 that Senate Rule 1 be amended as follows:

10 **COMPOSITION AND POWERS OF THE SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

11 The Senate Executive Committee shall be comprised of

- 12 ~~A. The Senate President, who shall serve as Chair;~~
13 ~~B. The President Pro Tempore, who shall serve as Vice Chair;~~
14 ~~C. The Deputies Pro Tempore;~~
15 ~~D. The Legislative Assistants;~~
16 ~~E. Standing and Ad Hoc Committee Chairs; and~~
17 ~~F. Standing and Ad Hoc Committee Vice Chairs.~~

18 **A. The Office of the Senate President.**

- 19 1. The Senate President, who shall serve as Chair, shall have voting and debating privileges and
20 shall count as one (1) towards quorum.
21 2. The Internal and External Legislative Assistants shall have voting and debating privileges
22 and shall count towards quorum only if the Senate President is not present.
23 3. In the event the Senate President is not present, either the Internal and External Legislative
24 Assistant must be present for the Office of the Senate President to count towards quorum.

25 **B. The Office of the Senate President Pro Tempore.**

- 26 1. The Senate President Pro Tempore, who shall serve as Vice-Chair, shall have voting and
27 debating privileges and shall count as one (1) towards quorum.
28 2. The Deputy Pro Tempore of Legislative Affairs and the Deputy Pro Tempore of Senate
29 Relations shall have voting and debating privileges and shall count towards quorum only if the
30 Senate President Pro Tempore is not present.
31 3. In the event the Senate President Pro Tempore is not present, either the Deputy Pro Tempore
32 of Legislative Affairs and the Deputy Pro Tempore of Senate Relations must be present for the
33 Office of the President Pro Tempore to count towards quorum.

34 **C. Standing and Ad Hoc Committee Chairs.**

- 35 1. Standing Committee Chairs shall have voting and debating privileges and shall count as one
36 (1) for quorum purposes.
37 2. Ad Hoc Committee Chairs shall have debating, but not voting privileges and shall not count
38 towards or against quorum.

39 **D. Standing and Ad Hoc Committee Vice Chairs.**

- 40 1. Standing Committee Vice Chairs shall have voting and debating privileges. They shall also
41 count as one (1) for quorum purposes only if their respective Chair is not present.
