### Senate Elections Postponed One Week

**ORLANDO, Fla. (September 15, 2019)**—Due to Hurricane Dorian and the first week of school being used largely to prepare for the hurricane, Student Government Senate Elections will be delayed one week pursuant to 604.9(B).

Regarding the delay, Student Body President Kyler Gray said, “After having discussions with Supervisor of Elections Julian Mayorga and members of Student Government it is imperative that we give more time for students to get involved in this organization.”

The new dates are as follows:

- Declaration of Candidacy packets: **September 27<sup>th</sup>**
- Elections: **October 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>**
- Election Results Announcements: **October 9<sup>th</sup>**
